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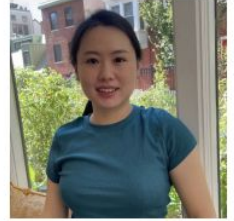

# Proposal Submission

## 1. Submitting Your NERA Proposal:

- Use the Online Proposal System.
- Deadline: **Friday, May 24, 2024, at 11:59 PM EDT.**

## 2. Research Project Requirements:

- Complete projects are not necessary; in-progress or nearly complete research will be considered.
- Show potential for readiness by the conference date.
- In-progress work encouraged for Roundtable presentations for interactive feedback.

## Proposal Submission<sub>(cont.)</sub>

- 3. Utilizing Content Strands:
  - Select primary content strand and two alternates.
  - Helps match proposals with appropriate reviewers.
  - Assists in placing proposals in suitable sessions.
  - Aids in assigning discussants.

- Educational Research Methods
- Educational Systems and Policies
- Higher Education Research and Practice
- Measurement and Psychometrics
- PK-12 Education Research and Practice

## Proposal Submission<sub>(cont.)</sub>

### 4. Session Options and Rigor:

- All session formats are peer-reviewed.
- Peer review ensures consistent quality across presentations.

### 5. Theme-based Paper Sessions/Symposia Submission Guidelines:

- Submit one proposal for all papers in the session (max 1,000 words).
- Include a description of how papers relate and brief descriptions of each paper.
- Indicate submission as a theme-based session/symposium in the system.

# Proposal Review and Acceptance

## 1. Review Process:

- Reviewers are NERA member volunteers, skilled in specific content strands.
- Final acceptance and session format are decided by the conference co-chairs based on reviews and program availability.

## 2. Research Paper Deadline:

- Completed research papers must be emailed to the discussant by **September 24, 2024**, to allow for adequate review time.

## 3. Unable to Attend:

- Accepting to present implies intention to attend.
- If unable to attend, and no coauthors or colleagues can substitute, withdraw by contacting the conference team at [NERA.CoChairs@gmail.com](mailto:NERA.CoChairs@gmail.com)

# Preparing for Your Presentation

1. Projector and Laptop Availability:
  - LCD projectors provided for each session.
  - Session Chair will arrange a laptop and facilitate file transfers via email.
2. Poster Specifications:
  - Use easels with 36 x 48 inches foam display boards.
  - Title, author, affiliation in  $\geq 36$ -point font; other text  $\geq 28$ -point font.
  - Include diagrams, figures, photos, and bulleted text.
  - Prepare up to four PowerPoint slides for electronic sharing before the session.

# Preparing for Your Presentation<sub>(cont.)</sub>

## 3. Roundtable Sessions:

- Interactive format with 3-5 researchers per table.
- No formal presentations; brief overviews and discussion encouraged.
- Focus on interactive discussions among researchers and participants.

## 4. Chair Responsibilities:

- Organize the presentation session.
- Manage papers, communication with authors, and AV equipment.
- Ensure session runs on time.

## 5. Discussant Role:

- Provide professional feedback and constructive criticism on presentations.
- Highlight connections to broader topics.

# Attending NERA

- Conference Registration Fees:
  - Fees will be posted on NERA website in late spring or early summer.
